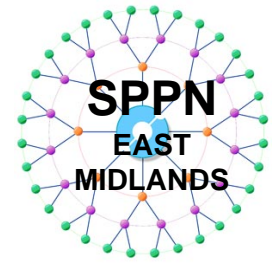

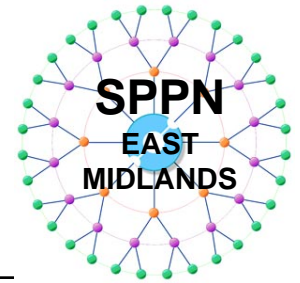

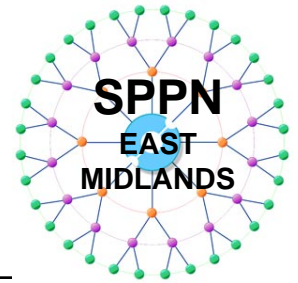

Overview: Why are LSP's important?

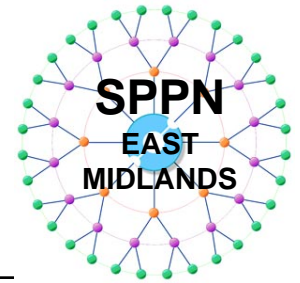
SP Funding:

- April 09 SP Grant included in LA's Area Based Grant (ABG) 09/10 identified as SPG, 10/11 not identified
- LSP's control use of ABG: Ring fence off
- 3 year settlement for SP up to 2011 significant cuts

Strategic Priorities:

- LSP's determine local priorities for National Indicator Set in their Local Area Agreement's (LAA's)
- Joint Strategic Needs Assessment (JSNA's) including health social care and housing inform priorities within LAA's
- SP Strategies due for renewal and will be expected to deliver appropriate LAA's and Sustainable Communities Strategy

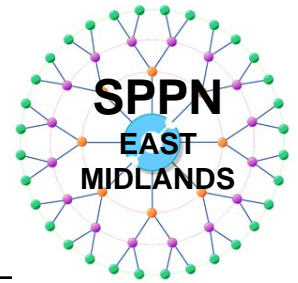
Understanding your Local Strategic Partnership



LSP's not new

- Pre existing LSP relationships traditionally with Voluntary Sector
- LAA NI 7 'Thriving Third Sector' includes Voluntary Sector and 'not for profit'/ RSL sector, frequent confusion
- SP sector coming out of SP 'silo', value/contribution of SP programme relatively unknown to LSP

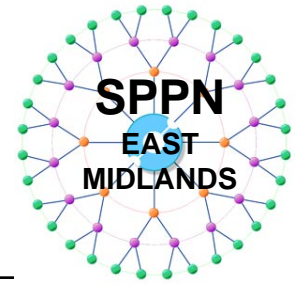

Current Provider understanding and level of engagement

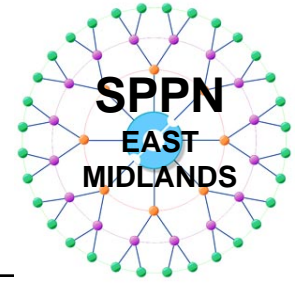

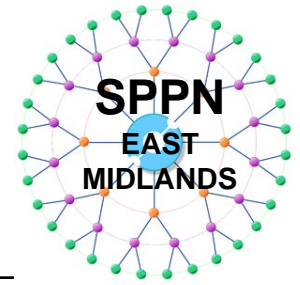
XXX (e.g.One Nottingham) /LSP Structure

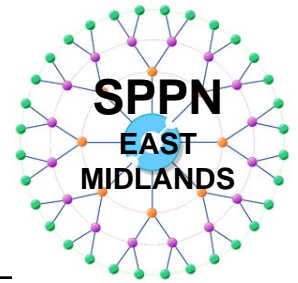
